

The Robert J. Dodd, Jr. Memorial Scholarship
For Students Involved in Theater

Deadline: The third Friday in March

The Robert J. Dodd, Jr. Memorial Scholarship for students involved in the NLHS Theater program awards one student annually. The scholarship amount is \$1,000, and the check will be made payable to the student's institution of higher education.

Mr. Dodd practiced law in New Lexington for over 50 years, and supported our community throughout his life. Mr. Dodd and his wife are longtime NLHS Drama patrons. They attended as many shows as possible, and Mrs. Dodd continues to support the theater department.

In order to apply for the scholarship, a student must complete the application form and turn it in along with an original essay and one letter of recommendation to the senior class guidance counselor. The essay must be 500-800 words in length. It must be typed, double spaced, and 12 point font. The font should be either Times New Roman or Arial.

Announcement of the recipient will be made at the school's annual awards ceremony.

To be eligible for this scholarship, a student must meet the following criteria:

- Have at least a 3.0 grade point average (gpa)
- Be graduating from high school in the current academic year
- Have participated in theater three of the four years of high school
- Have participated as an onstage performer or a member of the crew in either the fall play or the spring musical (or both) every year they were active in theater
- Have applied and been accepted for enrollment in a formal program of further post-secondary education (including trade schools, etc).

Essay topic is:

How has being actively involved in the theater program positively impacted my life?
