#### Disease

prevents or impairs an animal's daily function and is harmful to development

# Physiological Defects

do not allow glands, organs or systems to function properly

#### Nutritional Defects

occur when animals do not receive adequate amounts of nutrients to function properly

## Morphological Defects

physical defects caused by an accident or negligence

## Pathogenic Organisms

microscopic organism that produces a toxin or poison which causes a disease and affects normal animal activity

#### Virus

resemble the same chemical make-up as the host cell and can kill and control the host cell with chemical compounds they create

#### Toxin

chemical compound created by a virus or pathogen normally antagonistic to the host

### Bacteria

microorganism that produce toxins, multiply rapidly and are capable of producing spores

# Protozoa

one cell and considered the simplest form of life

# Fungi

small parasitic spore-producing organisms; cause fungal diseases

### Prevention

steps taken to inhibit illness in animals
